Heard:

- Presentation from Mr. Tim Moloney, Superintendent of Schools, Ms. Sandra Connolly and Mrs. Amelia Thompson, Student Achievement Consultants, Learning Support Services, re the PVNC 2014-2015 Catholic Board Improvement Plan for Student Achievement and Well-being (CBIPSAW), including Leveraging Technology for Learning, and Administrative Procedures 825-101 – Concussions. The presentation offered highlights on the three pillars of the CBIPSAW – Teaching and Learning, Personal Pathways and Wellbeing and Living our Catholic Faith. On March 2, students of St. Anthony Catholic Elementary School in Port Hope showcased their energy conservation practices to Minister of Energy Bob Chiarelli and Northumberland-Quinte West MPP Lou Rinaldi.

During the Minister and MPP's visit, the St. Anthony EcoTeam, led by Teacher, Denis Desjardins, conducted a school energy tour alongside local energy provider Veridian Connections. The students highlighted the work they've done to create a school culture of conservation and contribute to a greener province.

St. Anthony is in its second year of certification with the Ontario EcoSchools program. Students lead environmental activities on a daily basis, with different grades taking on different responsibilities.

St. Anthony is part of a network of 1,745 certified EcoSchools in 53 different school boards across the province that are working to develop environmental citizenship.
