GRADES 7 & 8 LITERACY AND NUMERACY SUMMER SCHOOL LEARNING PROGRAM

Welcome...

The Peterborough Victoria Northumberland and Clarington Catholic District School Board offers a Summer School experience to assist intermediate students with their literacy and numeracy skills and their transition into secondary school. Students will also have the opportunity to explore career options through their individual pathway plans (IPP). Choosing appropriate program pathways ultimately will help students achieve their educational potential.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Summer School is available to all current Grade 7 and 8 students. Students **MUST** have their Principal support their application by submitting a **Principal Referral Form** available on the PVNCCDSB Summer School web site.

WHY CHOOSE THE GRADES 7 & 8 SUMMER SCHOOL LEARNING PROGRAM?

Summer School is an opportunity for students to improve their skills and potential academic achievement.

Summer School provides many opportunities for students to apply skills in a practical and fun-filled manner.

Summer School provides an opportunity for students to develop self confidence and self directed learning skills.

LUNCH

Students are expected to bring a lunch, snacks, and drinks to summer school.
(Please be aware that some sites may have dietary restrictions if allergies to certain foods are present).

ATTENDANCE

Students are expected to arrive on time, and to attend every day of their program.

Note: A student will be removed from, and fail to receive an evaluation for, any course in which she/he has been absent for any reason for more than two (2) days in their program. If a student is late by more than 15 minutes four (4) times, it will count as one (1) day absent unless the school Principal has been contacted.

MATERIALS

On the first day of class, a \$25 deposit may be requested for the use of resources (i.e. textbook). The deposit will be refunded upon the return of the loaned materials at the end of the program. Cheques can be made out to PVNCCDSB. All supplies and textbooks are loaned to students for the duration of Summer School only. The deposit will only be cashed if books are lost or damaged.

BUS TRANSPORTATION

Transportation in rural areas may be available from local pick-up points at some, but not all, sites. Students can obtain this information by contacting Student Transportation Services of Central Ontario (STSCO) at (705) 748-5500, Toll Free 1-800-757-0307 or visit the web site at www.stsco.ca

Note: Since public transit is available within each of the host school's urban areas (i.e. City of Peterborough, City of Kawartha Lakes and Bowmanville) transportation is not provided to students residing within the city limits in these areas and therefore, is the family's responsibility.

Students are expected to dress appropriately for summer learning. The program includes daily kinesthetic activities to foster a positive learning environment, however, if a student is inappropriately dressed, they will be sent home to get changed. Uniforms are not required.

Note: Each school site is air conditioned.

FINAL SUMMER SCHOOL REPORTS

Students' reports will be mailed in August. Reports will be sent to home schools during September. For Grade 8 students, reports will be sent to their Secondary School.
