Voluntary 9-1-1 Registration

This voluntary registration program has been developed to assist City of Peterborough residents who are deaf and hard of hearing.

Registration with our 9-1-1 dispatch will enable emergency services to provide appropriate response to 9-1-1 emergency calls where communication barriers exist. Qualified registrants are residents of the City of Peterborough who are deaf or hard of hearing with reduced ability to communicate with 9-1-1 operators via regular telephone. In the event a 9-1-1 call is received from the registered address, information specific to the communication barrier will be available to emergency services.
