POLICE NOTIFICATION

At a minimum, the police must be notified of the following types of incidents:

- Ⓐ all deaths;
- Ⓐ physical assault causing bodily harm requiring medical attention;
- Ⓐ sexual assault;
- Ⓐ robbery;
- Ⓐ criminal harassment;
- Ⓐ relationship-based violence;
- Ⓐ possessing a weapon, including possessing a firearm;
- Ⓐ using a weapon to cause or to threaten bodily harm to another person;
- Ⓐ trafficking in weapons or in illegal drugs;
- Ⓐ possessing an illegal drug;
- Ⓐ hate and/or bias-motivated occurrences;
- Ⓐ gang-related occurrences; and
- Ⓐ extortion.
