PVNC reaches tentative collective agreement with occasional teachers

PETERBOROUGH – Peterborough Victoria Northumberland and Clarington (PVNC) Catholic District School Board and PVNC Occasional Teachers are pleased to announce a tentative agreement on local terms and conditions.

The Board and Ontario English Catholic Teachers' Association (OECTA) members representing occasional teachers have been negotiating virtually through videoconferencing and came to the tentative agreement on June 18, 2020.

“This tentative agreement is great news. We are pleased to move forward with our hard-working occasional teachers as we continue to face unique and challenging times ahead,” said Joan Carragher, Superintendent of Human Resources.
