

Catholic Graduate Expectation A REFLECTIVE, CREATIVE AND HOLISTIC THINKER



A Reflective, Creative and Holistic Thinker who:

- a. Recognizes there is more grace in our world than sin and that hope is essential in facing all challenges.
- b. Creates, adapts, evaluates new ideas in light of the common good.
- c. Thinks reflectively and creatively to evaluate situations and solve problems.
- d. Makes decisions in light of gospel values with an informed moral conscience.
- e. Adopts a holistic approach to life by integrating learning from various subject areas and experience.
- f. Examines, evaluates and applies knowledge of interdependent systems (physical, political, ethical, socio-economic and ecological) for the development of a just and compassionate society.

Grandfather Teaching HONESTY - GWAYAKWAADIZIWIN

Honesty is represented by the sabe. The sabe understands who they are and how to walk in their life. "Sabe reminds us to be ourselves and not someone we are not. An honest person is said to walk tall like Kitchi-Sabe.

To walk through life with integrity is to know honesty.

Be honest with yourself. Recognize and accept who you are. Accept and use the gifts you have been given. Do not seek to deceive yourself or others.

The Sabe represents honesty because it is closer to the Creator than to humans. It is believed that the Sabe used to walk among humans to remind us of the Creator's wish for us to remain true to our natural forms.

Actions such as being true to our spirit and accepting who we are will guide us in being honest.


Prayer Service / Non Eucharistic Liturgy
