Protecting the health and well-being of our community remains our top priority. Durham Region Health Department (DRHD) is committed to supporting schools in partnership with the local school boards.

## **Public Health Measures**

Due to the Omicron surges (BA.1.1 and BA.2 sub-variants), DRHD strongly recommends that students and staff continue to wear a wellfitted three-layer mask in shared indoor spaces. Masking, coupled with other public health measures such as physical distancing, proper hand hygiene, and staying home when sick, continue to be effective strategies for reducing the spread of COVID-19. ## Vaccination

Vaccination remains a vital tool in our ability to overcome this virus. While many Durham residents have already received their first, second and third doses of COVID-19 vaccine, I encourage you to continue to emphasize the importance of vaccination with school staff, students, and their families. In addition, DRHD has expanded the eligibility for fourth doses of COVID-19 vaccine for individuals 60 and older, as well as First Nation, Inuit, and Métis individuals and their non-indigenous household members aged 18 and older, as announced by the
