APPENDIX B - ACTIVITIES NOT APPROVED

Many activities are not approved because they are unsafe and carry an unacceptable level of risk for the Board. These activities include, but are not limited to the following:

ACTIVITIES NOT APPROVED:

- aircraft/helicopter rides (private pilot)
- axe-throwing
- bmx biking
- bouncy castles
- bungee jumping
- crossbow
- diving
- dunk tanks
- firing range
- gliding
- hang-gliding
- hot air balloon rides
- outdoor rock climbing

- paintball
- parachuting
- parasailing
- scuba diving
- skydiving
- snow resort terrain park
- swimming at a private pool
- trampoline parks
- warfare games
- white water kayaking
- white water rafting
- zip-lining (outside of Canada)

The following activities carry a higher risk but may be approved based on their educational value, curriculum connections, program needs and planned risk mitigation strategies. These activities require written approval from the school's Family of Schools Superintendent.

ACTIVITIES REQUIRING WRITTEN SUPERINTENDENT APPROVAL:

- aircraft/helicopter rides (commercial pilot)
- fencing
- high ropes

- horseback riding
- indoor climbing
- outdoor climbing walls
- zip-lining (within Canada)

The Board reserves the right to add or delete activities to these lists at any time.
